Avoid False Humility

□ *Col. 2:18-23* Do not let anyone who delights in false humility and the worship of angels disqualify you for the prize. Such a person goes into great detail about what he has seen, and his unspiritual mind puffs him up with idle notions. He has lost connection with the Head, from whom the whole body, supported and held together by its ligaments and sinews, grows as God causes it to grow. Since you died with Christ to the basic principles of this world, why, as though you still belonged to it, do you submit to its rules: "Do not handle! Do not taste! Do not touch!"? These are all destined to perish with use, because they are based on human commands and teachings. Such regulations indeed have an appearance of wisdom, with their self-imposed worship, their false humility and their harsh treatment of the body, but they lack any value in restraining sensual indulgence.

Now, we're going to look at a model prayer of a humble servant. Let's break this down and discuss what it saying. Let's dig in and pull this thing apart.

1 *Chr. 17:16-27* "David's Prayer" (Read in your Bible)

- 1. 16-18 David prayed by humbling himself.
- 2. 19-20 Praising God.
- 3. 21-22 Recognizing God's blessings.
- 4. 23-24 Accepting God's decisions, promises and commands.

Let's pray our own prayer of Humility following David's pattern.

Begin by humbling yourself:

Praise God

Recognize His Blessings

Accept God's Decisions, Promises, & Command.

When God uses someone else to implement your ideas, will you respond with this kind of humility?

Just a reminder about staying humble before the Lord:

- 1. Apart from Christ, our sinfulness Luke 18:13, 14
- 2. Apart from Christ, our unworthiness Luke 15:17-21
- 3. Apart from Christ, our limitations 1 Kings 3:6-14
- 4. God's righteousness Phil. 3:4-7

Remember that God resists the proud and gives grace to the humble. Stay humble before the Lord and experience His favor. God bless you!


