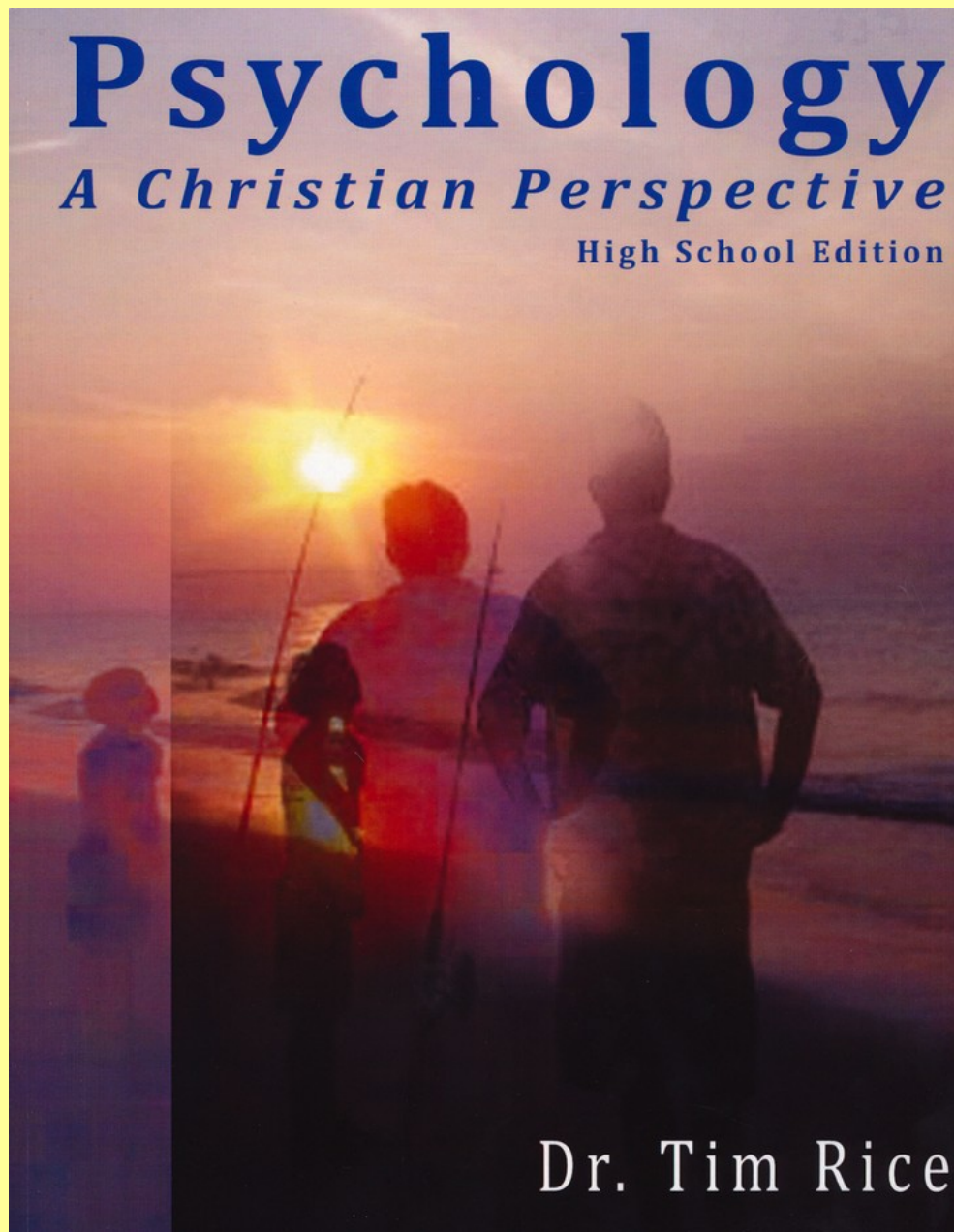


Psychology 101

We hope this will be a blessing and inspire you to create your own classes and unit studies.

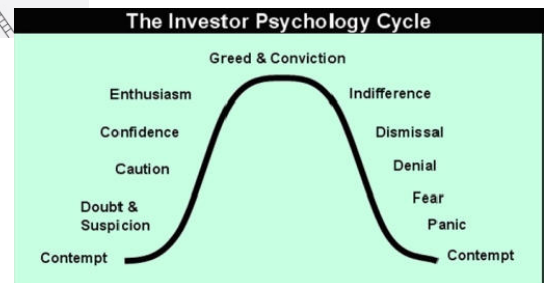
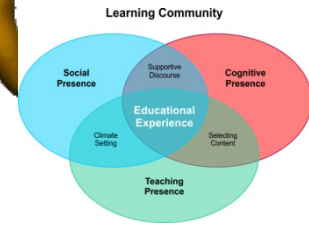
